Contribution to inflation in past 12 months



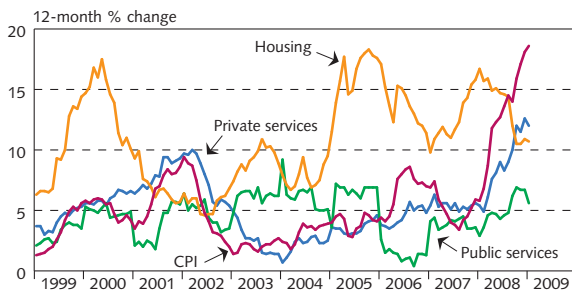

Breakeven inflation rate at month-end and inflation expectations according to surveys

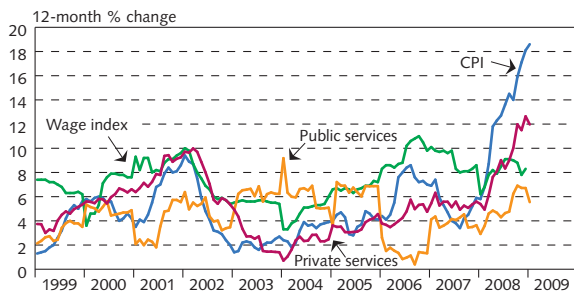

and prices of imported goods in the CPI



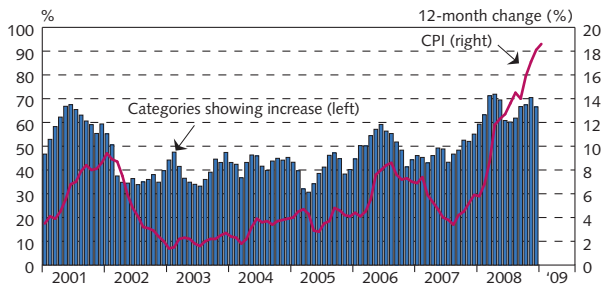

Month-on-month CPI and exchange rate change



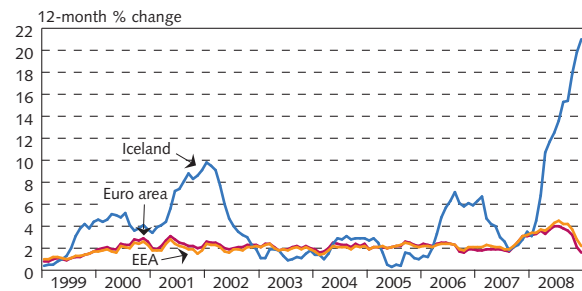

January-September 2006-2008



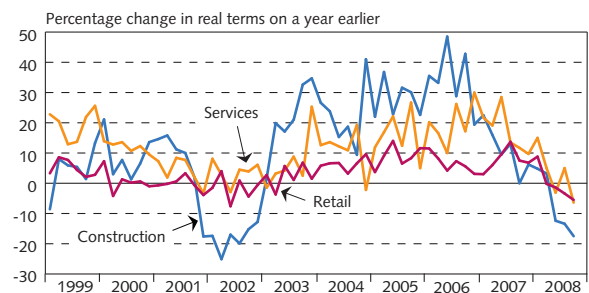

Seasonally adjusted



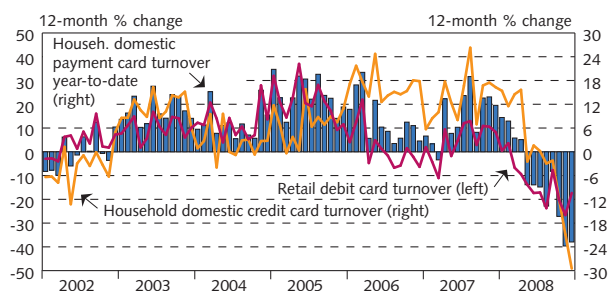

Selected sectors



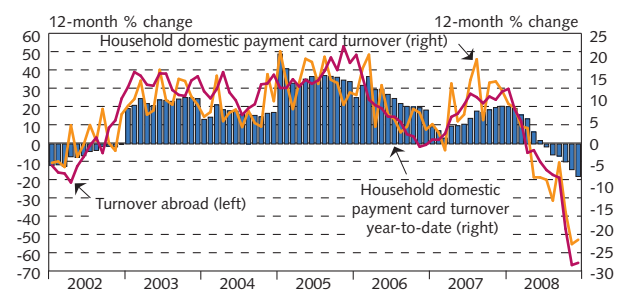

12- and 3-month moving averages, at fixed exchange rates



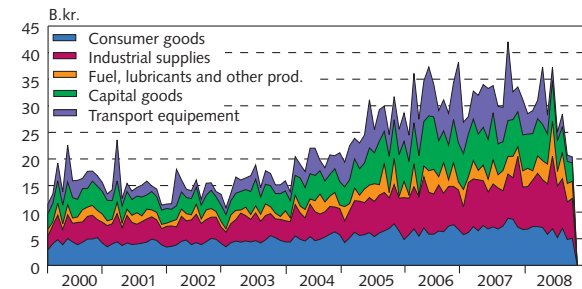

Export value at fixed prices



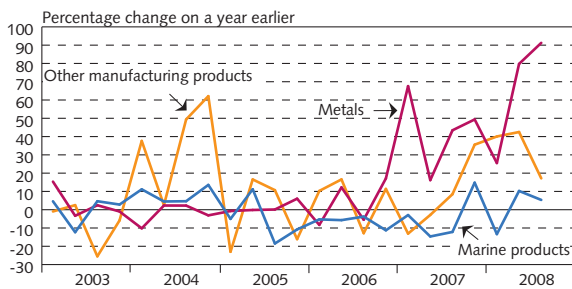

3-month moving averages, at fixed exchange rates

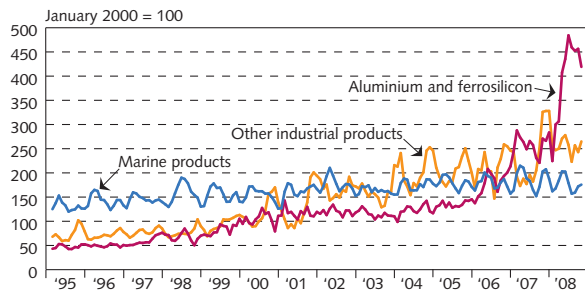

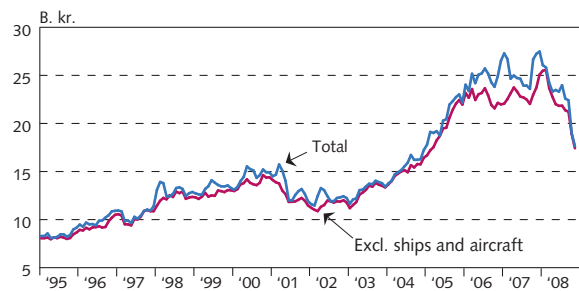

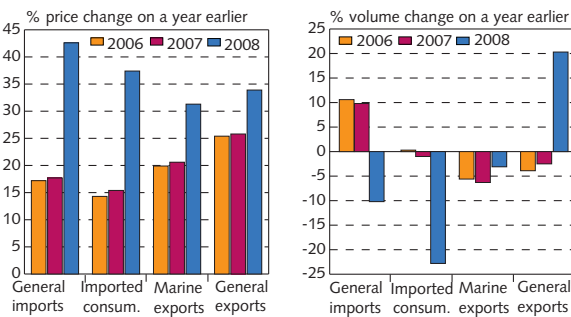
Seasonally adjusted merchandise imports

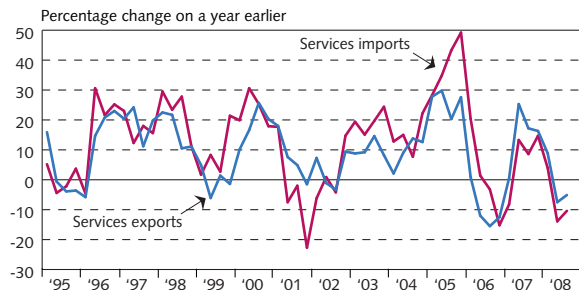
Merchandise trade in January - November 2006-2008

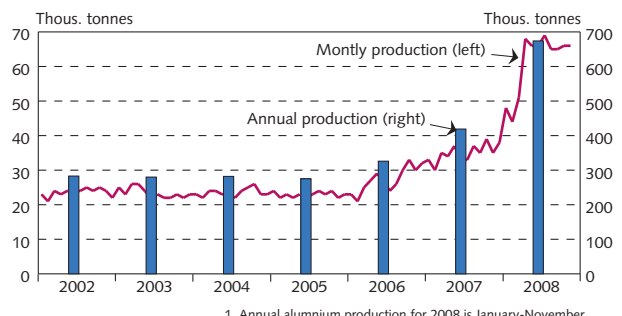
Currency-weighted for marine exports and in USD for aluminium

Contribution of age groups to total hours worked



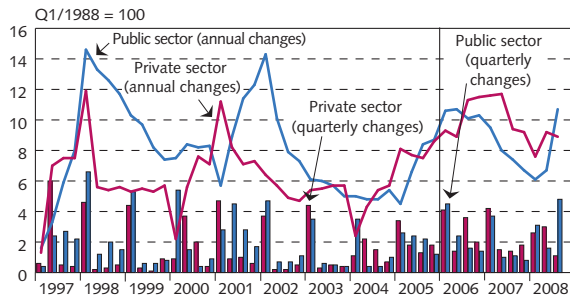

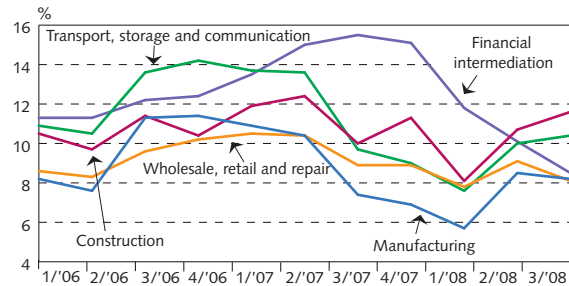

Statistics Iceland wage index



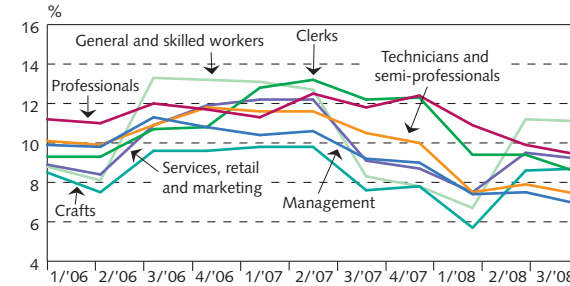

Percentage change on a year earlier



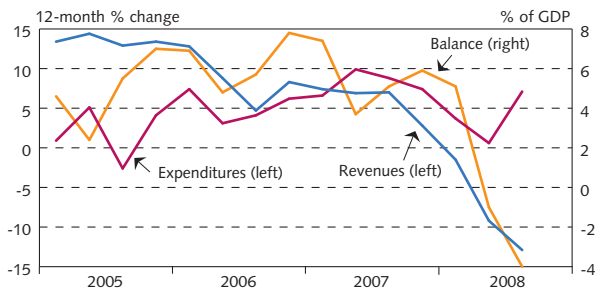

Percentage change on a year earlier

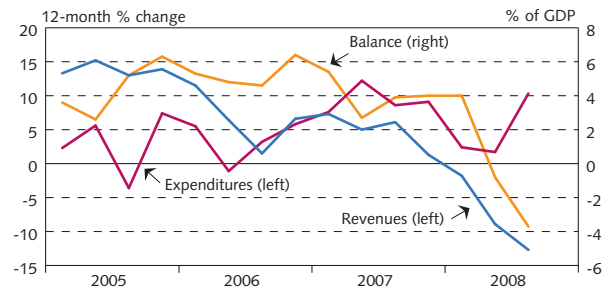

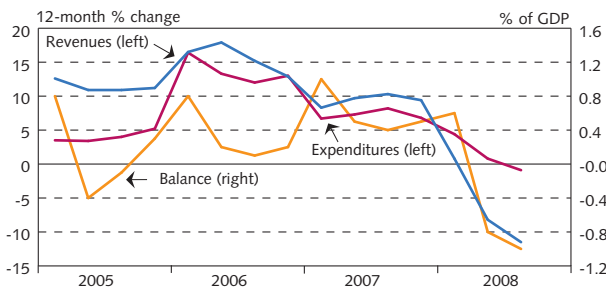

In real terms deflated by CPI



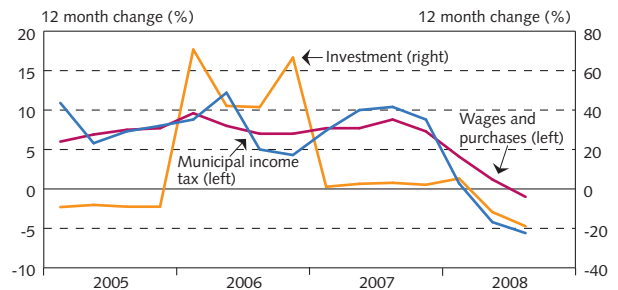

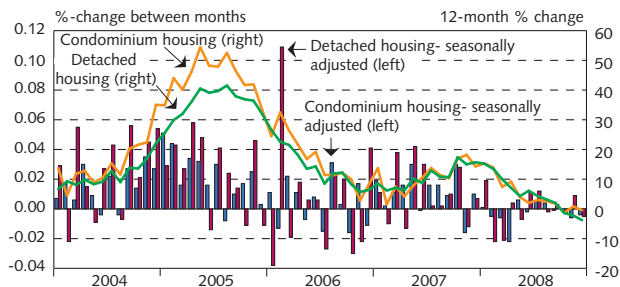

Price per m², 3-month moving averages



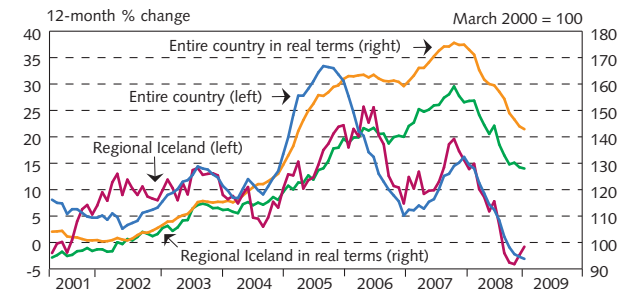

Condominiums and detached housing



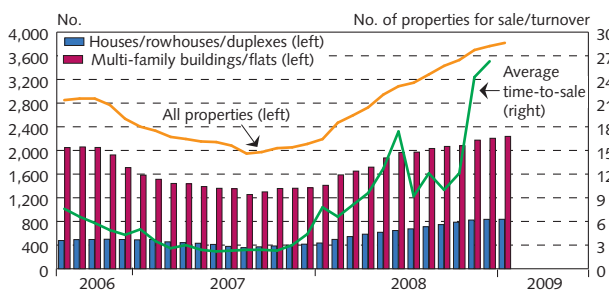

Entire country and regional Iceland



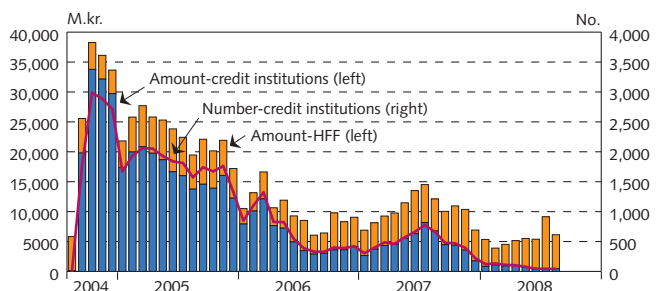

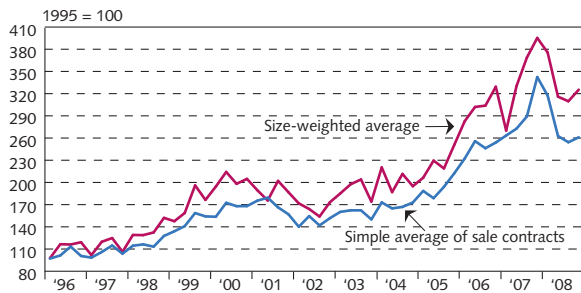

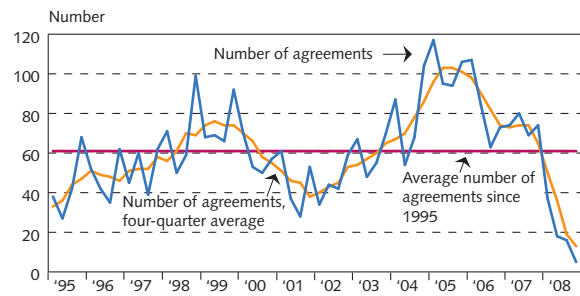

Weighted average of industrial, retail and office premises in real terms



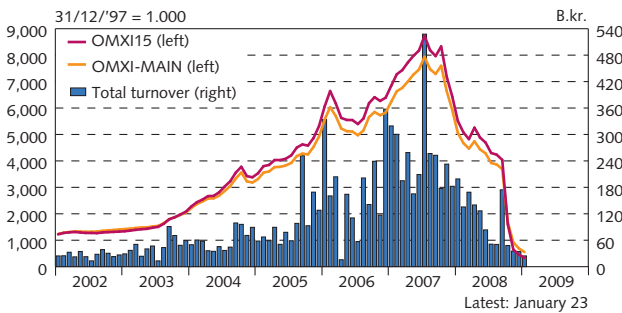

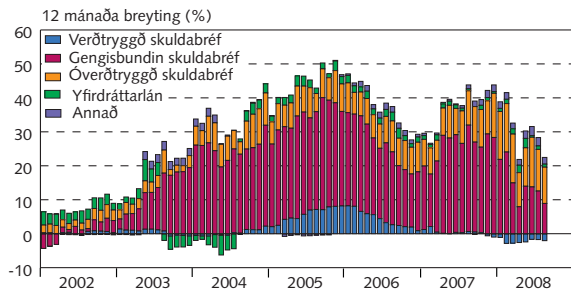
Growth of M3 and DMB credit to domestic sector

Balance sheet of the Central Bank



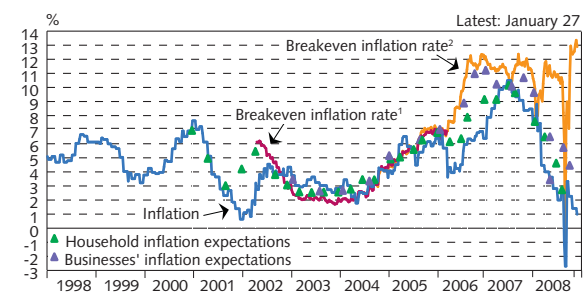

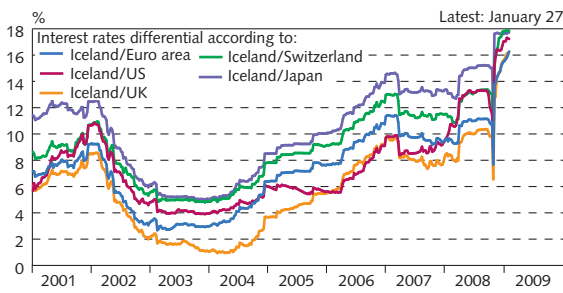
Central Bank policy interest rate in real terms

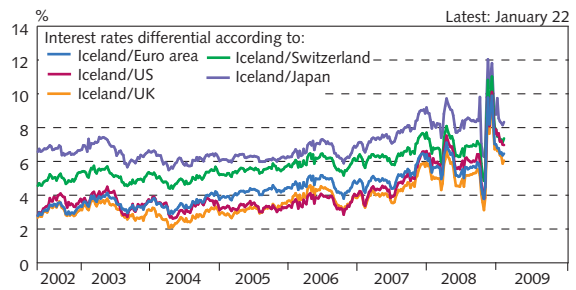

3-month interbank rates



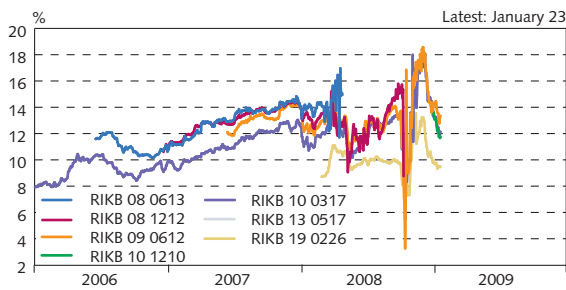

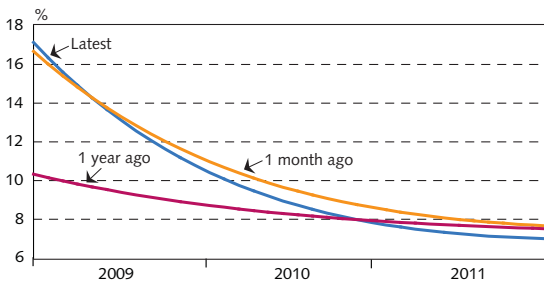

Housing loans' lowest interest rates



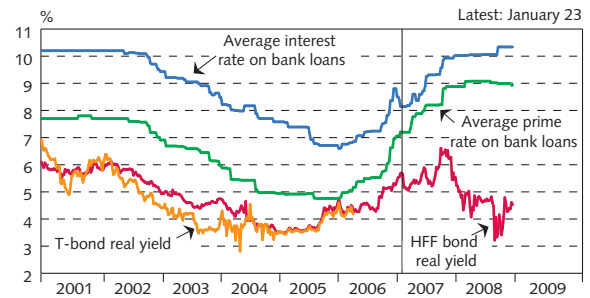

Bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds

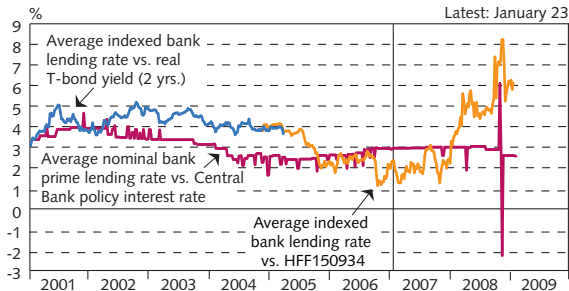

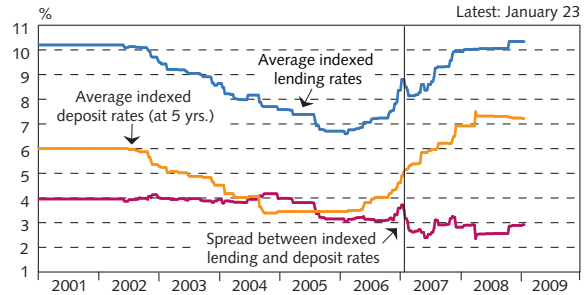
Between nominal bank prime rates and the policy rate;
