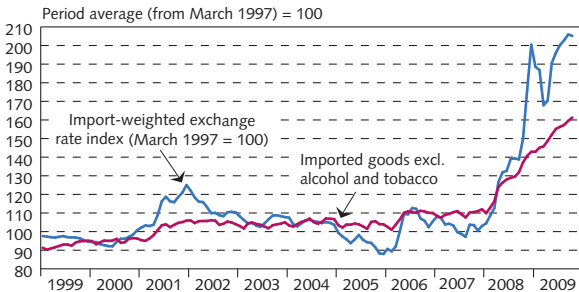

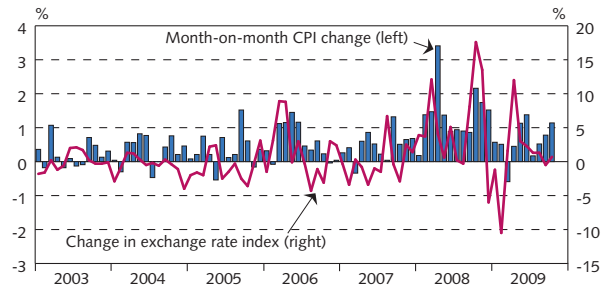

Goods, housing and services



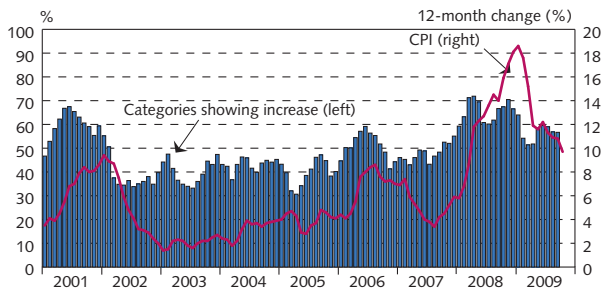
I-11 Import-weighted exchange rate of the króna and prices of imported goods in the CPI



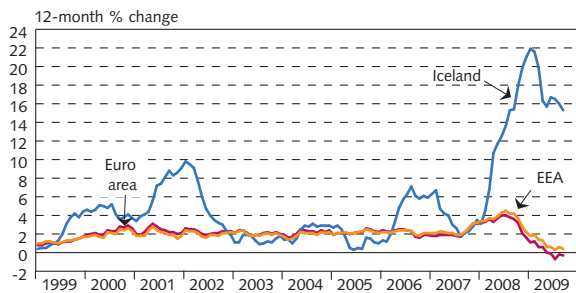
I-12 Price and exchange rate development

I-13 Distribution of price increases in CPI

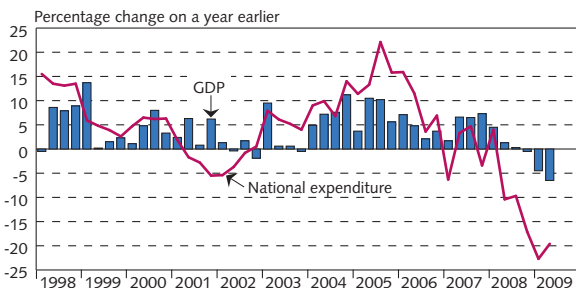

2006-2008



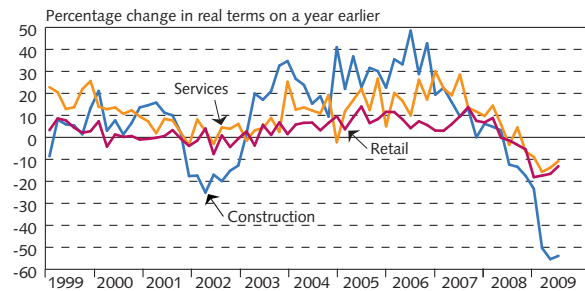

Seasonally adjusted



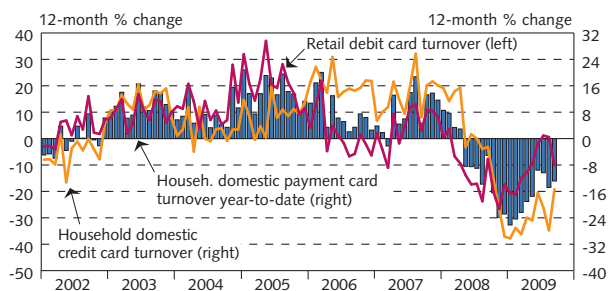

Selected sectors



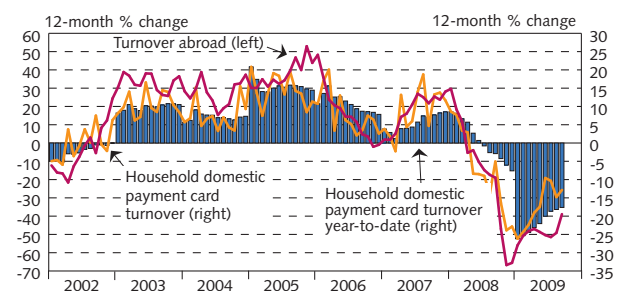

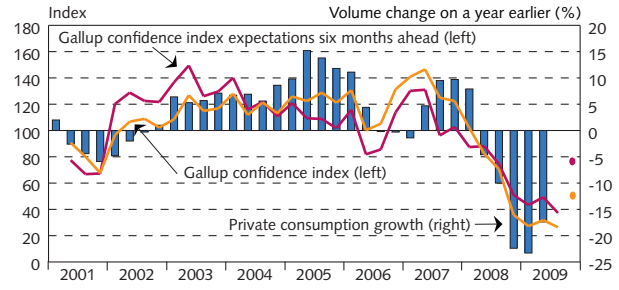
Index, current situation and expectations six months ahead

12-month moving averages



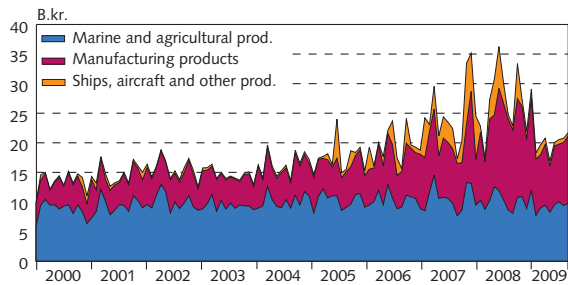

12- and 3-month moving averages, at fixed exchange rates



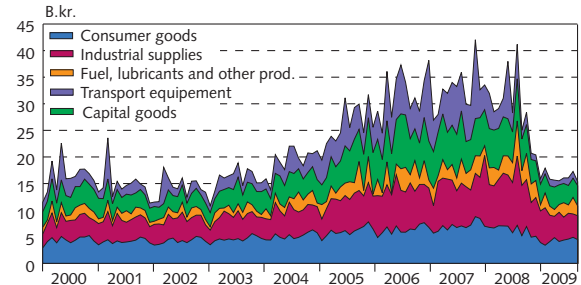

Export value at fixed prices



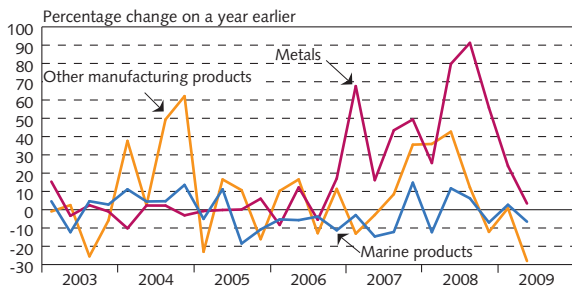

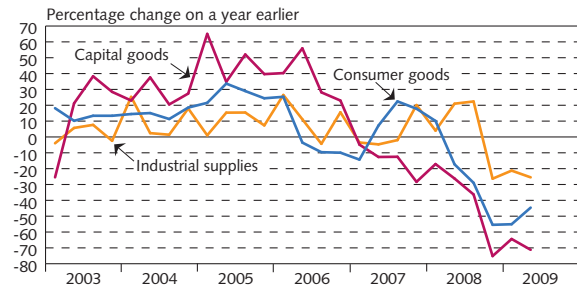

Quarterly data



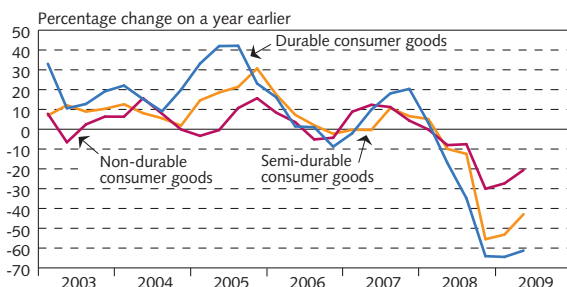

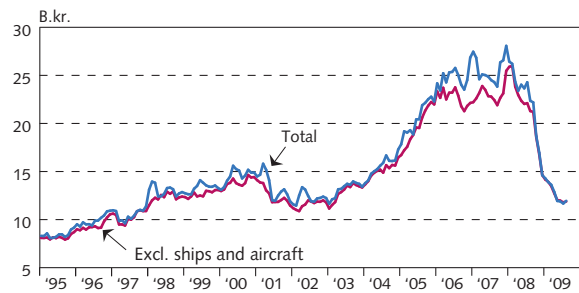

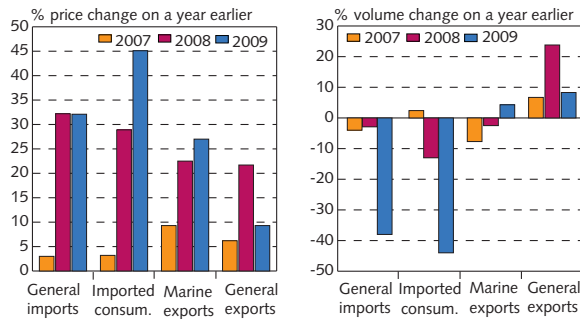
#### Seasonally adjusted merchandise imports

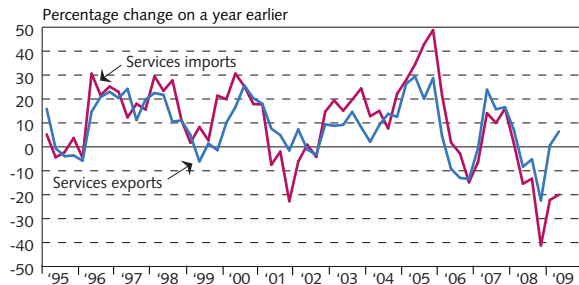
#### Merchandise trade in January - August 2007-2009

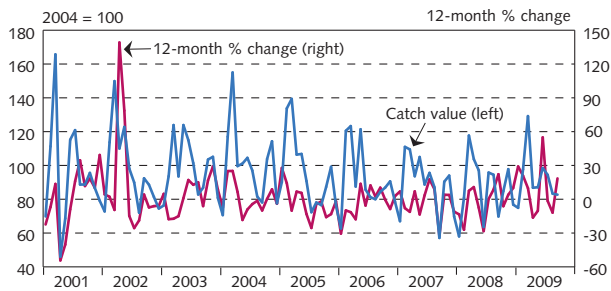

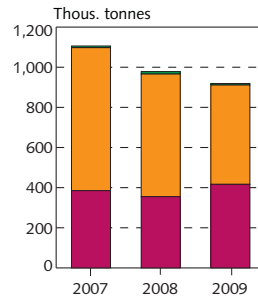
#### Fish catch volume

Statistics Iceland wage index



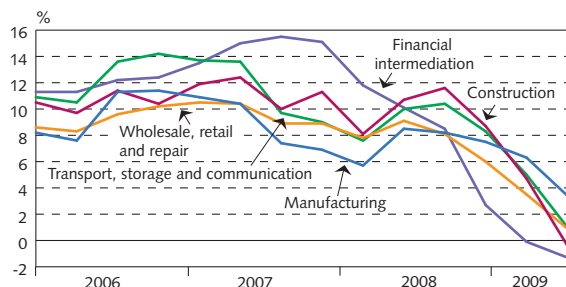

Statistics Iceland wage index



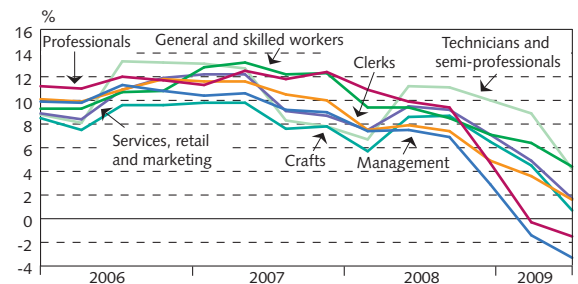

Percentage change on a year earlier



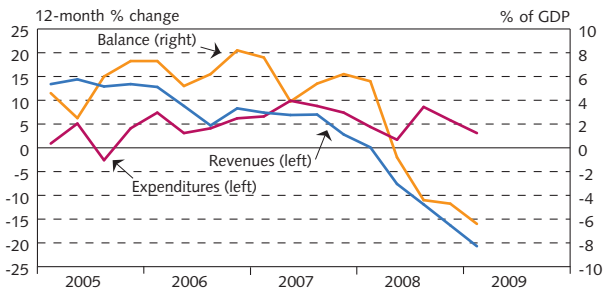

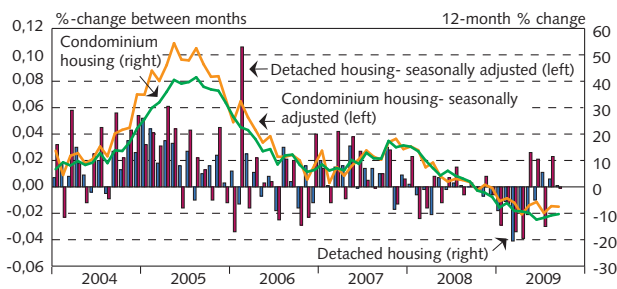

Price per m², 3-month moving averages



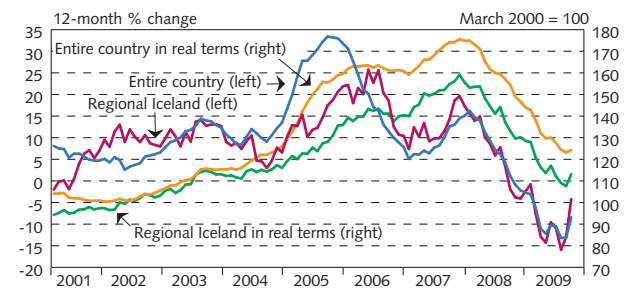

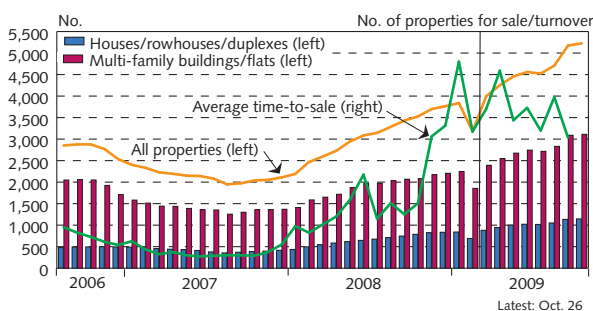

Entire country and regional Iceland



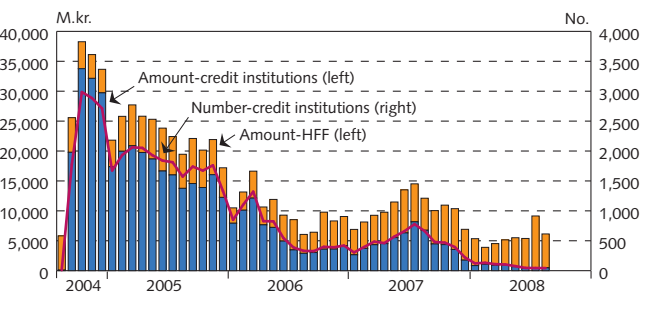

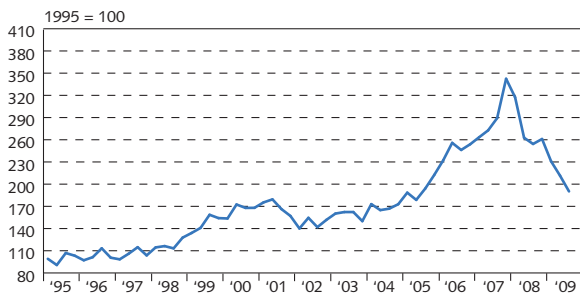

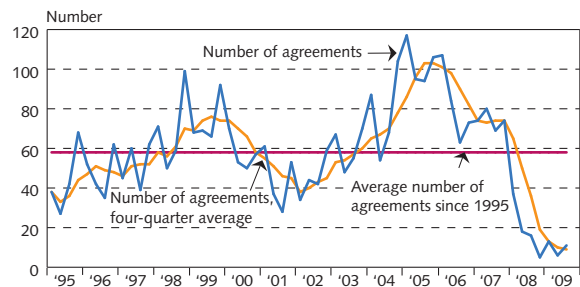

Weighted average of industrial, retail and office premises in real terms



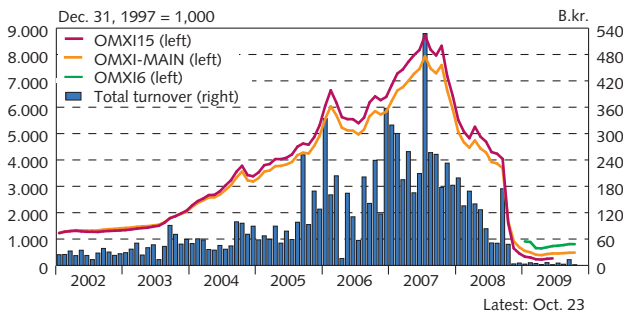

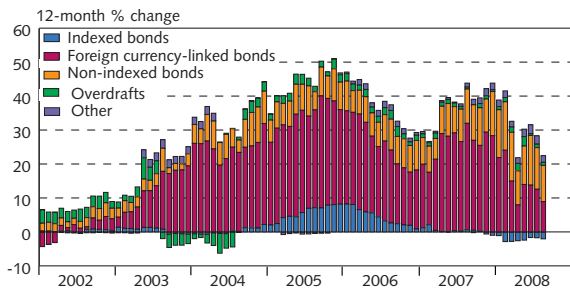
Growth of M3 and DMB credit to domestic sector

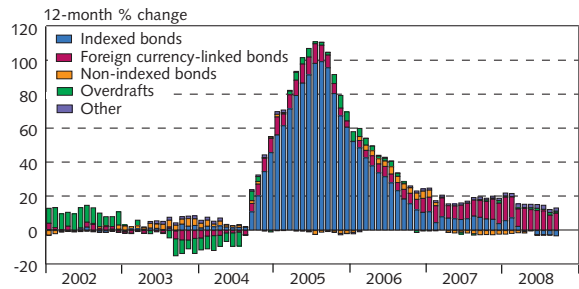

Contribution to credit growth



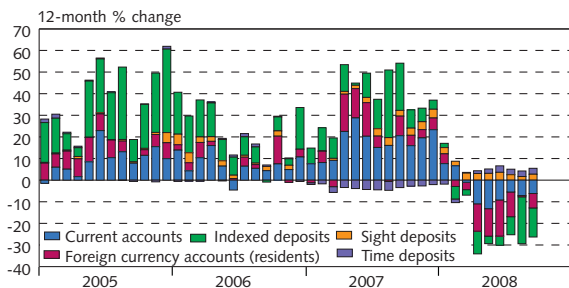

3-month moving averages



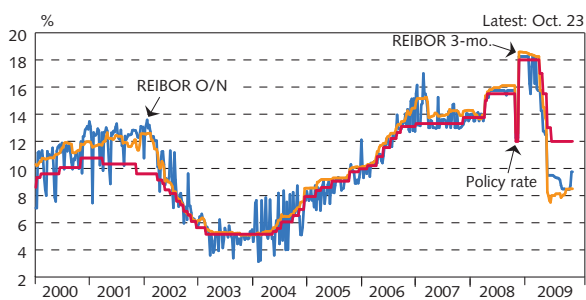

3-month interbank rates



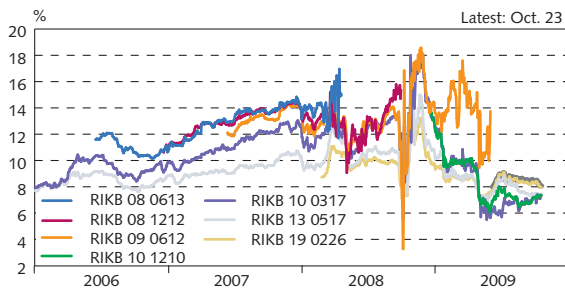

10-year governments bonds



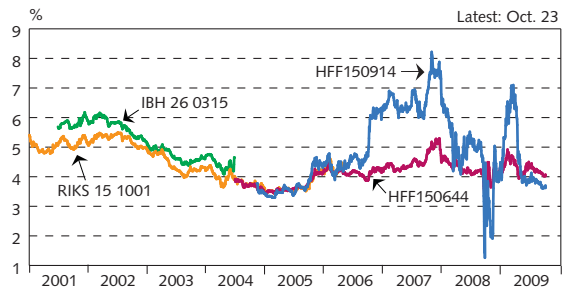

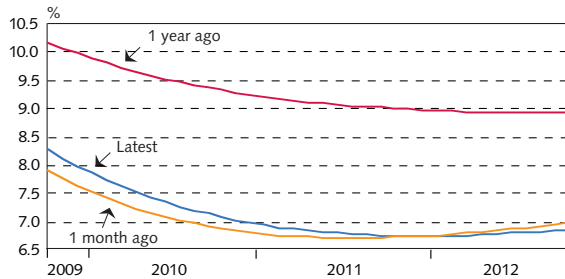

Housing loans' lowest interest rates



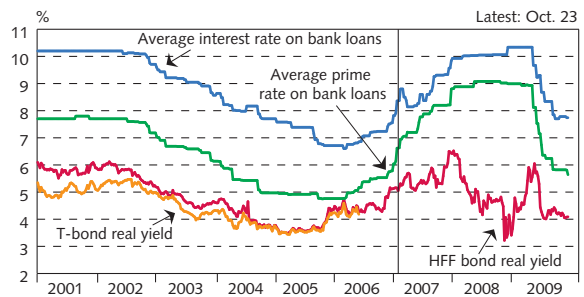

Bank lending rates and real yield on housing bonds and T-bonds



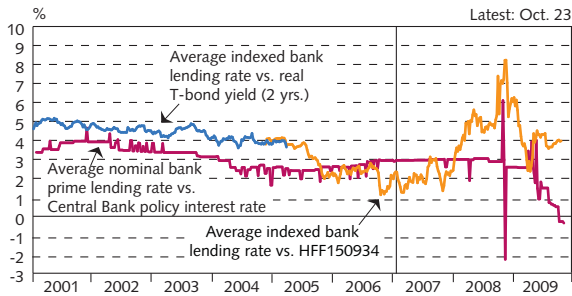

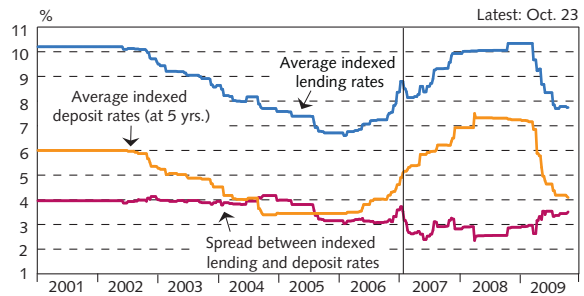
