Foreword from the National librarian

The policy of the NATIONAL AND UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF ICELAND is to be a source of knowledge for everyone. It serves the Icelandic community in all areas of reference and academic discipline and plays a leading role in the collection, preservation, and dissemination of information, thus making a vital contribution to culture, research, and innovation.

The operations of the year 2020 were heavily influenced by the Covid-19 pandemic. The operational balance of the year 2020 was negative, due to an unfavourable rate of the Icelandic króna, and extra expenditures. Vacant positions were filled when necessary but FTE's decreased by one. Travel, training, and conferences were suspended or cancelled. Maintenance of the library building continued as usual, and the storage in Mjódd was redesigned, and compact moveable shelves and pallet racks installed. Foreign paper material in the cellar of the library building, now available in electronic format, was weeded.

The formation of a new strategy for the NULI started in December 2019. It was put aside because of Covid-19 and the process was heavily delayed. A draft on an Open Access Policy was published in the Government consultation portal. Work on Equal Pay Certification continued (compliance to the Equal Pay Standard ÍST 85:2021), also work on step 2 in Green Steps in Government.

In 2019, the Consortium of Icelandic Libraries that runs the common library system for Icelandic libraries started, after a tender, the implementation of a new library system, Sierra and the Inspire discovery tool from the company Innovative. Another company, ExLibris, acquired Innovative in late 2020 and by the end of the year it was decided that the Landskerfi will implement the library system Alma and the discovery tool Primo VE. The implementation of the Pure system (Current Research Information System) continued, but the process was delayed because of Covid-19. The website <code>leikminjasafn.is</code> and an underlying database of theater performances and actors were reconstructed, and a specialist was hired to the Theatre Archives.

The NULI became a member of OpenAIRE AMKE, a European Commission funded service that supports open access and open science in Europe, and the main task will be the establishment of a national Open Access information desk for Iceland.

The Covid-19 pandemic changed the operation of the NULI in many ways. The Library building was closed for the public 16th of March - 4th of May or 7 weeks, and again 5th of October - 11th December or nearly 10 weeks. When the building was open, it was usually from 9:00 - 17:00, and closed in the evenings and on weekends. The executive committee discussed the situation in weekly meetings, and a team of key people from all departments was established, to react to changes and spread information to the public. The staff canteen and public cafeteria was closed. Some of the staff took up remote work after consultation with their supervisers and remote meetings became the main communication channel. That will continue in the future. Information services on the Internet, by email and telephone was reinforced and patrons could order paper material and fetch and return it at the library service entrance. Usage of e-material and e-services increased. Daily operations changed according to the Covid-19 situation and restrictions concerning number of guests, masks, hygiene, distance etc. Very few of the staff were infected by Covid-19.

Government Policy 2010-22

Operational budget for 2020 was processed according to laws on public finances no. 123/2015 (LOF), in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, as well as policy planning for the next three years. The priority tasks of the library for the next years fall into the category of 18.1 *Museums*, in the Budget, but also categories 7 *Research*, *innovation*, *knowledge* and 21 *Universities*. The goals and projects were revised, as the older ones had been achieved, and some became part of the daily operations. The goals for 2020 are:

Core Activity:

- Registration of cultural property research and cataloguing,
- 2. Storage preservation of cultural heritage,
- 3. Enhancement of research and cataloguing.

Operational Factors:

- 1. Implementation of Green Steps in Government,
- 2. Improvement of records management and quality control.
- 3. Improvement measures for human resources,

The progress of these goals is accounted for in the next chapter, but the policy spans three years and will be revised annually.

Core activity

1. Registration of cultural property

More and more emphasis is on registration of the diverse collections, other than print, within the NULI. It gives better information about the collections and access becomes easier. Among new goals are more registrations of private documents on the web einkaskjol.is, registrations and digitization of manuscripts on the web *handrit.is*, as well as registrations and digitization of old Icelandic books on the web bækur.is. At the end of the year there were nearly 1.700 private archives on einkaskjol.is, The current system has not been updated, and a search for a new one has already begun. On *handrit.is* there are entries for more than 12.000 manuscripts, and 6.500 belong to the NULI. On baekur.is there are 2.000 digitized titles. In the beginning of the year, the minister of Education and Culture signed a declaration of intent about the preservation and registration of Icelandic music recordings from local studios. The NULI participates in the management of the web einkaskjol.is, with the National Archives and local archives, and there are now 282 records from the NULI on the web. The website leikminjasafn.is and an underlying database of performances and actors were reconstructed.

2. Storage - preservation of cultural heritage

The main collections are in the National Library building and if branches and depositories are included, in 12 other places. New shelves were installed in a storageroom on the 1st floor. After a TV program about storages of cultural institutions in October, it was decided to improve conditions in the storage in Mjódd. The project was in cooperation with the owner of the premises. A project of weeding foreign serials in storages of the NULI building started, to make space for Icelandic preservation material. The storages in Reykholt are nearly full, and it was emphasized that new storages outside of Reykjavík are needed. It was discussed with the Ministry and a memorandum sent to explain the situation. Cataloging of the material in Reykholt into the library system Gegnir, is also in priority, to gain a comprehensive overview of the whole collection. Preservation and weeding will be easier.

3. Enhancement of research and cataloguing

Every year the NULI takes part in several research projects and contributes with data and expertise. A coordinated Icelandic catalogue of Icelandic persons and names for libraries, museums, and archives, has

been discussed for some time. Under the auspices of the Centre of Digital Humanities at the University of Iceland, it was decied that several institutions would apply for a grant in the Innovative Fund at Rannis. A grant was not provided, but a new application will be sent next year.

The NULI leads the implementation of a CRIS system (Current Research Information System) that is aimed to preserve information about Icelandic research and research publications, and the operation of the PURE system acquired by the Ministry of Education last year. The process was delayed because of Covid-19

It can also be mentioned that a policy of preservation of cultural heritage was published by the Cultural Heritage Agency in August, but it was formulated by specialists from the cultural heritage institutions.

Operational factors

Implementation of Green Steps in Government

Work on Step 2 was in focus and at the end of the year 25 actions out of 40 were finished, but institutions must finish at least 36. The process was delayed because of Covid-19. The benefit of Green Accounting was explored. 30 employees get transport subsidy and use environment friendly transportation.

Improvement of records management and quality control

New cases in the records management system were 150, which is lower than expected. Because of Covid-19, goals for records management were not achieved, but at the end of the year, a draft for a new classification scheme was compiled, and preparations for the purchase of a quality system started. Deposition of the digital database Skemman to the National Archives was finished but required a lot of work. The register of committees counted 55.

Improvement measures for human resources

The NULI got an *Equal Pay Certification* and the right to use the Equal Pay Certification badge in 2019. In 2020 the system was reviewed on behalf of the company Vottun. New components of the human resources system Orri were activated, such as vacation requests and registrations for education and training. Improvements were made on the working environment, and the aim is to implement Microsoft365 in 2021.

Key statistics

At the end of each year, statistics are processed and published. Several alterations have been made over the years, in line with changed operations. The statistics are presented regarding the standard *International Library Statistics*, *ISO 2789:2013*. Numbers of the tables match numbers in the standard. Consortium of Icelandic Libraries processes statistics of Library holdings from the library system Gegnir, and more emphasis is on analysis of statistics by gender.

1. UNITS AND BRANCHES

The National and University Library of Iceland serves the Icelandic population, counting 364.134 on January 1st 2020, but serves all other customers. It is also the library of the University of Iceland with 14.992 enrolled students in autumn 2020. The Library is one administrative unit, but operations and library holdings are on following locations:

2. SERVICES AND USAGE

Library users include those who visit the Library and those who use services on its websites. Guests using the Manuscript Department and National Department reading room on 1st floor are counted; precise counts of other users are not feasible, but surveys are made of users of the open areas on other floors in the first week of each month. On weekdays during the university examination season, the number of users can reach up to 300-350 (see table 2.10). A solution from the company Camlytics, for monitoring the number of people in the building was taken in, for trial.




2.10 Guest using 2nd floor 2019 - 20209







2.10 Guests using 3rd og 4th floor 2019 til 2020¹⁰
