

# Foreword from the National librarian

The aim of the NATIONAL AND UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF ICELAND is to be a source of knowledge for everyone. It serves the Icelandic community in all areas of reference and academic discipline and plays a leading role in the collection, preservation, and dissemination of information, thus making a vital contribution to culture, research, and innovation.

The operational balance of the year 2019 was negative, due to an unfavourable rate of the Icelandic króna, and extra expenditures. Vacant positions were filled when necessary but FTE's decreased by one. Travel, training, and conferences were kept to a minimum. Maintenance of the library building continued, installation of safety glass in the entrance was finished, as well as maintenance of the general management systems.

In May the Library acquired Equal Pay Certification and permission to use the Equal Pay Symbol. It is a verification that the wage system is compliant to the Equal Pay Standard IST 85:2021. Members of the staff participated in the formation of an Open Access policy for Iceland on behalf of the Ministry of Education, and a formation of a new strategy for the NULI started in December. A new design for the websites was adopted and the new main website was opened on March 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Ministry of Education acquired a CRIS system (Current Research Information System) after a tender, and the NULI was assigned to install and operate the system for all universities and research institutions in Iceland. The project *Green Steps in Government* continued, and the first step was finished. Law on support to publication of books in Icelandic were accepted. The NULI and the National Museum made an agreement to receive the collections and properties of the Theatre Museum of Iceland, with a support from the Ministry of Education. The Library receives books, documents, and the website *leikminjasafn.is* and an underlying database of performances and actors.

The 200th years anniversary of Jón Árnason, the first national librarian and a collector of Icelandic folktales, was commemorized, in cooperation with the Árni Magnússon Institute and the municipalities of Skagaströnd and Skagabyggð, but Jón was born at Hof in Skagabyggð. The sculptor Helgi Gíslason made two reliefs of Jón. One was placed in the National Library, and the other was erected in the town Skagaströnd. The Postal Service issued a stamp with a picture of Jón Árnason The International Internet Preservation Consortium (IIPC) organized a hackathon in April in the NULI, to umprove a tool to compare screenshots and indicate problems, but also to develop a tool for analysing and comparing crawl logs.

The annual meeting of Nordisk Center for Teaterdokumentation was held in the Library May 16<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> because the Theater Museum of Iceland became part of the Library and the National Museum. The NING group (Nordic Information Network Gender) had an annual meeting in the Women's History Archives May 21st, and in June the NordLic group confered about subscriptions of digital material. Guðný Halldórsdóttir gave the Library a relief of her father, the Nobel prize author, Halldór Laxness. The Library staff was invited to a Christmas buffet to commemorize that the new Library Building was opened December 1<sup>st</sup> in 1994.

# **Government Policy 2019-21**

Operational budget for 2019 was processed according to laws on public finances no. 123/2015 (LOF), in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, as well as policy planning for the next three years. The priority tasks of the Library for the next years fall into the category of 18.1 *Museums*, in the Budget, but also categories 7 *Research, innovation, knowledge* and 21 *Universities.* Extra effort was made in planning projects within the current Library policy, *Knowledge Source for Everyone.* The goals for 2019 are:

#### Core Activity:

- 1. Improve access and dissemination of culture and arts,
- 2. Increase digital historical material on the websites of the,
- 3. Improvements in buildings and security measures, especially for legal deposit reserves.

#### **Operational Factors:**

- 1. Improvement measures for human resources,
- 2. Implementation of Green Steps in government,
- 3. Improvement of records management.

The progress of these goals is accounted for in the next chapter, but the policy spans three years and will be revised annually.

# **Core activity**

# Improve access and dissemination of culture and arts

The number of web services are 28. Visits increased by 27.4% and page views by 0.9%. New online services on the main website, are reservations for Library orientation, Information searches and Instructions on how to deposit material in the Open Sciences repository. 15 websites have interfaces for smart devices. The main web of the Library was updated with a new layout and design in March, and the experience and accessibility improved. Nine exhibitions were opened, and *Highlights of the month* were introduced on the main website.

#### Increase digital historical material on the websites

Increase of digitized images of manuscripts and paper was just over 150.000, and more than 6 million images are accessible on the Library websites. The focus was mainly on bækur.is, handrit.is and hljodsafn.is (books, manuscripts, and sound). The number of titles on bækur.is increased from 1.705 to 1.850 (8.5%) and the number of manuscript titles increased from 2.450 to 2.590 (5.7%). The number of digital sound files increased from 37.857 to 42.623 (12.3%), and digital files with covers and lyrics counted 16.200 at the end of the year. Other historical sources on the websites are bibliography of Saga translations, einkaskjol.is, a repository of archival records, *ismus.is*, a repository for Icelandic music and Lykilskrá with coordinated subject headings and names, plus historical webs s.a. Women and politics and about the poets Hallgrímur Pétursson and Jónas Hallgrímsson.

#### Improved security measures

The main collections are in the National Library building and if branches and depositories are included, in 12 other places. The main storage facilities are in the Library building, in Reykholt and in Mjódd. A considerable effort has been made in weeding and streamlining the collections, improving metadata, plus a new set of rules for reception of gifts. A memorandum on storages and security measures was sent to the Ministry of Education in November, as well as suggestions for improvements. More safety glass was installed in the library entrance and the sliding door in the main entrance was renewed. Maintenance on several management systems for the building continued.

# **Operational factors**

#### Improvements for human resources

The Library got the *Equal Pay Certification*, and could use the Equal Pay Certification badge in 2019. An Equal Pay Policy was adopted in 2014, and the Library has taken part in a pilot program on implementing the Equal Pay Standard IST 85:2012, on behalf of the Ministry of Finace since 2013. The Equal Pay Certification confirms that the salary system of the Library is compliant to the Equal Pay Standard. Some statistics with gender analysis are provided for in the Annual Report. The results of the survey *Institution of the Year* dropped a few points. The staff was pleased with gender equality and also with the canteen. Results for acoustics and overview of the job dropped a little.



#### Implementation of Green Steps

Participation in the *Green Steps program* started 2017. The goal was to finish actions for step 1 and that was completed in February. The Library got a certification signed by the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources. Work on step 2 started.



#### Improvement of records management

Work on a new design for documents, reports and diverse print material according to the new design standard continued. Work on a new classification scheme for the records management started. A copy of the digital database Skemman, has been deposited to the National Archives and is a work in progress. The register of committees counted 55. The number of registered cases in the records management system GoPro increased.

# **Key statistics**

At the end of each year, statistics are processed and published. Several alterations have been made over the years, in line with changed operations. The statistics are presented regarding the standard *International Library Statistics, ISO 2789:2013.* Numbers of the tables match numbers in the standard. Consortium of Icelandic Libraries processes statistics of Library holdings from the library system Gegnir, and more emphasis is on analysis of statistics by gender.

#### **1. UNITS AND BRANCHES**

The National and University Library of Iceland serves the Icelandic population, counting 356.991 on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019, but serves all other customers. It is also the library of the University of Iceland with 13.092 enrolled students in autumn 2019.<sup>1</sup> The Library is one administrative unit, but operations and library holdings are on following locations:

#### 2. SERVICES AND USAGE

Library users include those who visit the Library and those who use services on its websites. Guests using the Manuscript Department and National Department reading room on 1<sup>st</sup> floor are counted; precise counts of other users are not feasible, but surveys are made of users of the open areas on other floors in the first week of each month. On weekdays during the university examination season, the number of users can reach up to 275-300 (see table 2.10)






#### 2.10 Guest using 2<sup>nd</sup> floor 2018 - 2019<sup>8</sup>
