


# 2. Splendid Combination -Dynjandi waterfall & villages

Arnarfjörður is widely considered the most beautiful fjord in the Westfjords because of its diverse landscape, magnificent mountains and the impressive waterfall Dynjandi, one of the most beautiful waterfalls in Iceland. Admire the highest mountain in the Westfjords, Kaldbakur and bathe in a hot spring pool surrounded by the beautiful Icelandic nature.

### The most impressive waterfall

The great waterfall Dynjandi, is the largest waterfall in the Westfjords, about 100 meters high and up to 60 meters wide. A hiking path leads up to the central gorge of the waterfall, allowing visitors to come close enough to touch the water as it tumbles down into the depths. Despite the isolation the nearby village Bíldudalur is vivid, with a high level of cultural life such as The Icelandic Sea Monster Museum. Tales of sea monsters have played a Colourful role in Icelandic folk culture for centuries. Today, these elusive creatures have been given a worthy home at the museum. The fishing village Tálknafjörður, is known for its natural hot pots, the swimming pool, fine camping grounds and extremely clean environment.



### How do you name a country?

Visit the monument of Hrafna Flóki who was the first Norseman to sail to Iceland in the year A.D.865. With three ravens for navigation to the new island, he came ashore in Vatnsfjörður, hiked up a mountain from where he spotted a large fjord, full of ice. Consequently he named the entire land: Iceland.

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## **Tailored Nature Tours**

### **Bird Watching Tours**

The bird watching season in the Westfjords of Iceland begins in April, with May and June offering the best opportunity of seeing the widest variety of species. Throughout the season you see the birds arriving and settling, nesting (preparing and building the nests), preserving their eggs, feeding the baby birds and finally coach them for flying and coping with the real world. Daylight is long at this time of the year, up to 24 hours, so you will have plenty of time to devote for sheer enjoyable birdwatching at different stages of the season.

Látrabjarg is the largest seabird colony in the Northern Atlantic. It is claimed to be the best place in the world to photograph puffins. Many other species are found in Látrabjarg cliff such as the Razorbill, the Brunnich's Guillemot, the Common Guillemot and the Fulmar, just to name a few. Látrabjarg is by far the only place in the Westfjords where rare birds can be found. The local guide will take you to the best places in the neighboring area to watch and photograph species you would not find on your own i.e. the White Tailed Eagle, the Common Loon etc. Westfjords Adventures offers both private tours and private group tours.




### 1. Pearls of the Westfjords

This tour will take us to the majestic 441m high Látrabjarg cliff. While exploring the magical birdlife of the largest seabird colony in the Northern Atlantic we will learn about the utilization history of the cliff and the famous rescue achievements in 1947-1948. Driving the rough track towards the deserted Keflavík you will enjoy the magnificent view over Rauðasandur, Breiðavík and Látravík.

### Steep rough roads and thrilling drive

The steep rough high altitude road to Kollsvík, provide a thrilling drive and literally a "helicopter's view" over Hænuvík



and the opening of the two fjords of Patreksfjörður and Tálknafjörður.

The large sandy cove of Rauðasandur is one of the most spectacular sites of Iceland. The red sand glows in the summer light, gathering its color from crushed scallop shells. We will stop by the French Café at Rauðasandur before we head off back to Patreksfjörður for a dinner and photo sharing after a memorable day.

2. The Cultural West

Enjoy the magnificent valleys, giant cliffs and yellow colored beaches of Ketildalir and the beautiful valley Selárdalur, on the west side of Arnarfjörður and visit the extraordinary museum of outdoor works, the Art Museum of Samúel Jónsson. Samúel was a self educated artist who could finally devote himself to his passion for art when becoming a pensioner. There is a great variety of big sculptures, paintings and Colourful houses in this remote and isolated place.

On our way through the historic, vivid Bildudalur town, we examine tales of sea monsters at the Sea Monster Museum.

Tálknafjörður is renowned for the small tidy fishing village, geothermal water, rich bird life and white sandy beaches. We explore both sides of the fjord including Europe's western most forest, the ruins of Suðureyri's whaling station and rest our legs in the local natural hot spring pool Pollurinn.

3. The Crown Jewel of Kjaran's "Avenue"

Enjoy the exceptional road constructions under steep rock near Svalvogar and stony beaches of Skútabjörg where you have to be aware of sea tide. Claimed by road experts to be mission impossible, Kjaran's avenue, named after it's builder, s is anything but an avenue; the narrow one-way jeep track is carved into the steep berg with the ocean straight down. This is one of the most incredible road constructions in Iceland and the scenery en-route is incomparable. This magnificent tours leaves no one untouched for its unique landscape and sheer thrilling drive experiene.

We get close to Kaldbakur, the highest mountain in Westfjords and might hike the top to enjoy incomparable scenery, weather and road conditions permitting. Alternatively we take the old winding main road through Hrafnseyrarheiði, which is closed for 6-8 months every year due to snow. Various stops and refreshments on our way.

2. Fjord Wandering

From Tálknafjörður we will cycle to Sveinseyri, with its own world of magnificent birdlife and white sandy beaches.

We will visit Sellátrar, old abandoned and very remote farm, now used as a summer cabin. Though it has always been the opinion of experts that trees are not able to grow in this area you can find the westernmost grove in Europe in Arnarstapi. In the shore below there are some remains of fisherman's huts, but until 1930 Arnarstapi was a popular place for fishermen to row out. It is said that Arnarstapi is an energy centre where you can recharge all your energy levels.

The hot spring pool Pollurinn is located in the hillside just outside the village of Tálknafjörður. It is a great way to relax after the bicycle tour and admire the extraordinary view over the fjord. On this tour you will see a great bird life and an incredible nature. The tour is especially recommended for nature lovers and photographers.

## 3. Bird Cliffs and Beautiful Beaches

The tour starts at the Tourist Centre in Patreksfjörður from where we will drive to Skápadalur, with the bicycle in tow. In Skápadalur we will see the oldest Icelandic steel ship, build in the year 1912.

From Skápadalur we will drive to Látrabjarg. All around you will see the breathtaking landscape. Látrabjarg is the westernmost point of Europe and is also claimed to be the best place in the world to photograph puffins.

It is a great fun to cycle from Breiðavík to the Heritage Museum at Hnjótur. In this interesting museum we will learn how Icelandic people lived in the old days by examining cultural values, e.g. household equipments and clothing, as well as learning about the people's lifestyle in the old days.

From Hnjótur we will cycle to Rauðasandur, the Iceland's most famous beach, red colored in a beautiful setting of black cliffs and blue sea. The local guide

will take you to places where the view is just incredible. The main characteristics of this tour are high speed, action, diverse landscape, culture and an amazing bird life.

### 2. Rauðasandur - breathtaking landscape

Rauðasandur is one of Iceland's most spectacular sites and most famous beach, red coloured in beautiful settings of black cliffs and blue ocean. If weather and visibility are good we can see all the way to Snæfellsnes peninsula and Snæfellsjökull glacier.

The Rauðasandur sandy beach takes its colours from pulverized scallop shells that have accumulated over the centuries. Seals are often seen on the beach, even sunning with their offspring.

### Forbidden romance

Our local guide willprofessionally lead the way through a breathtaking landscapeand tell local stories, such as of the forbidden romance between adulterous couple at the farm Sjöundaá in the beginning of the 18th century, which has been dealt with in literature and theatricals for decades.

We will stop at the French Café to enjoy the beautiful view and unique tranquillity of Rauðasandur.

### 3. Patreksfjörður on foot

This is a great way of getting to know the charming Patreksfjörður town by heart, rich of commercial and cultural history, the birthplace of many known artists, a base for English, French and German fishermen, marchant and naval mariners in the early days. The guide will walk us through the vivid harbour area and the fish market, show local traditional dried fish being processed, visit the Pirates House in the old smithy to

learn of piracy in the early days, show us the church's pulpit artwork created by the renowned artist Erró, stop by at the memorial of the snow avalanche in 1983, to name only few.

On this tour you will get to know the village and its history while inhaling the local atmosphere.
